


ENVIRONMENTAL WEEDS

OTHER WEEDS OF THE ANGLESEA FORESHORE


Many garden plants have become weeds after their seeds have been dispersed along the coast and into bushland via birds and wind. As they have no natural competitors, many of them have become widespread and are now difficult to control.

This poster shows some of the less common weeds, though still a problem locally. If you see or remove any of these plants, please report them (see below). It is important to check the site for years for regrowth from roots or seedlings.






ASPARAGUS FERN




ITALIAN BUCKTHORN



BOXTHORN




PURPLE GROUNDSEL


