Background

- Painkalac Reservoir was constructed in 1979
- Supplied water to Aireys Inlet & Fairhaven
- Designed to fill & spill not to provide for flood mitigation
- Managed under a Bulk Entitlement which stipulates minimum passing flow requirements
- Taken offline when Aireys Inlet and Fairhaven were connected to the greater Geelong water supply system in 2016



Community vision for future use

- 2016 Painkalac Reservoir future uses community and agency group established
- 2017 Based on recommendations from the group, Painkalac Reservoir opened to the public for:
 - Walking
 - Mountain bike riding
 - Horse riding
 - Bird watching
 - Land based recreational fishing




Environmental flows

- 2016 Painkalac Creek environmental flows community and agency group established
- Mid 2017 Environmental watering proposal endorsed
- Early 2018 release of environmental flows commence
- Releases are made to support low flow requirements and provide periodic freshes






Storage level and downstream flow
